The Tour De Bretagne 23rd and 24th June 2023

We have started the planning stages of next year's Tour de Bretagne, so make a note of the dates, Friday 23rd & Saturday 24th June 2023. We are returning to the Golf Hotel in Ploemel, in South Eastern Brittany close to the Atlantic Coast next year. We were very pleased with the service at the hotel when we were there in 2017 and there is more to discover in the area, so we are looking at new venues to visit, and of course providing enjoyable and drivable routes.

A real difference next year is that we are proposing to have 2 start locations one at Roscoff and one at St Malo, giving the choice for those of you who find sailing from either Plymouth or Portsmouth more practical Locations. Both groups will start at approximately 09:30 from a venue close to the Ports and we will then meet up at a venue and then on to Lunch at Huelgoat. After lunch, we'll all make our way to the hotel for the evening, possibly a swim and a pre – dinner drinks alongside the pool and terrace.

The cost of next year's Tour de Bretagne is £875 of which a deposit of £175 is payable. The entry form /Jot form will be available on the Website from Friday 22nd July '22. Bank details are on the form and more details to follow.



The Prologue Classic – 29th March to 1st April 2023

Just a reminder that we are off to Derbyshire next year, for the Prologue we'll be staying at the Casa Hotel for three nights (included in the entry fee), The Casa sits on the edge of Chesterfield and the Peak District National Park, and we're thoroughly looking forward to discovering some new venues and countryside roads and scenery.

We are limiting the entries as usual to 35 maximum. Entry forms / Jot forms are on the website. The Entry fee is £945 which includes 3 nights bed & Breakfast accommodation at the Casa Hotel, 2 evening group dinners one of which has been described as a Banquet Menu, also included is the entry fee to the venues and luncheon on both days.
